

Tom Baltz has been a fly tier for over 40 years. The last 30 have been spent among the legendary tiers of the limestone valleys of south central Pa. Tom is the only four time Pa. State Fly Tying Champion, and his flies have appeared in Field & Stream, Fly Fisherman Magazine and the recently published book "GuideFlies". He is also a regular contributor for Mid-Atlantic Fly Fishing Guide. A full time fly fishing professional since 1974 and one of Pa's first licensed guides. Tom is an Orvis Endorsed Fly Fishing Guide who was named by Orvis as North East Trout Guide of the Year in 2001. Tom is also a member of the Regal Pro Staff. Tom lives in Mount Holly Springs, PA.



Bob Clouser is a fly fishing guide and, teaches fly tying, fly casting and fly fishing for both fresh and saltwater fish. He has freshwater and saltwater fly fishing/casting schools at various locations around the country. He hosts trips to great fresh and saltwater fishing locations. He has written two books "Clouser's Flies" containing 16 of his world wide recognized fly including, the Clouser Minnow, Half and Half, Clouser Crayfish and the Crippled Minnow. His other book "Fly Fishing for Smallmouth in Rivers and Streams", rated by Fly Fisherman Magazine as best on the Subject. He has received many awards for his conservation work. Eric Stroup is a fly fishing guide, writer and fly tier from Spruce Creek, Pennsylvania. Eric and his wife Tracey own and operate Stroup Fly Fishing, and are deeply invested in the preservation and promotion of the fly fishing industry, its resources and its future. He has written magazine articles and books, produced videos and is a nationally known speaker.
