
1st Lifetime Achievement Award - Mark Your Calendar

'Streamside Tippets' - written wisdom from the Masters



Chapter 3 'WET FLIES - A New Look at Old Techniques' page 86-87." Wet Fly Fundamentals to learn and follow to be successful:

The Cast "this is the one time you want to straighten the line out - you have to be in touch with those flies with the rod tip"

Eliminate the belly in line throughout the drift "if the cast is out-and-across the stream, follow the line in the water with rod tip completely through the drift"

90 degree angle of line from rod tip to line in water is a necessity "Trout don't grab they inhale - there is enough slack in 90 degree angle for trout the trout to hook itself"
